Auction Information

As of 7-3-2020, this is the procedure that will be followed. Announcements from the auction block the day of the sale will take precedent.

Bidding and buying live in person on the grounds as in the past is still an option.

If you chose to be on the grounds, social distancing guidelines will be observed at the live auction.

You may bid and buy via livestream with online bidding: PutneyAuction.com (will be open online July 13th)

Pre-register early or you can register the day of auction. If you bid online, you will need an email address.

Invoices may be paid day of auction or will be emailed following auction and due August 3rd, 2020

There will be no food or water available for purchase on the grounds, so please come prepared with your own.

Sale bills will be posted around the arena, please bring paper and pen to plan accordingly and to record your purchases. Another alternative is taking a photo of the sale bill with your device's camera. A QR code will be made available for download of the sale programs. A paper program is a touchpoint and not acceptable currently.

Thursday, July 23rd---Sheep and Goat Auction-- Sale begins at 5:30 PM

Packer-buyer is available with the price TBA

Weigh in weight for show on Thursday AM will serve as the sale weight.

Sell in large show ring starting with goats and proceeding to sheep.

Monday, July 27th---Chickens, Swine, Cattle Auction-- Sale begins at 8 AM

As of 7-3-2020, the expectation is that there will be 14 pens of chickens, 97 hogs, 49 market beef. There are fewer numbers so the auction may not take as long as in the past.

Broiler/Roaster Chicken Pen of Three sell *first* in small animal ring

Buyers may purchase for their own use and pick up dressed birds at 5 PM Monday at the fairgrounds.

Buyers may purchase birds to be donated to the Indianola Food Pantry after being dressed.

Swine sells *second* in the small animal ring

Exhibitors may sell up to 2 hogs only

To support the 4-H/FFA exhibitors the Milo Locker will act as a packer buyer for hogs. Price TBA

Each hog will only sell one time, if the buyer does not want the meat, the Milo Locker will buy at packer price.

Leighton Locker will process up to twenty hogs, but the buyer must be willing to pay processing and take the meat.

Cattle sells *third* in the large animal ring

Cattle will be weighed at 6:30 AM Monday morning with feed and water removed at 10 PM on Sunday.

Milo Locker has custom processing spots if the buyer wants the meat.
