### • Entries: General

- Entries will be taken June 15, 16, 17 from Noon to 7 PM.
- Entry forms will be available at the time of entries.
- Warren County Fairgrounds—Grandstand Ticket Office—stay in your vehicle to properly social distance only getting out to come to the window.
- 2020 Fair book rules still apply.
- Fair books cannot be shared. Fair book is available online or can be purchased for \$5 at the grounds.
- Entry fees are posted in the Fair book on page 5. (Entry Fees are non-refundable if guidelines shut down large gatherings at the end of July)
- You will be asked at entry time how many market animals you would like to sell if an auction is available.
- 4-H rules regarding YQCA, animal ID in 4-H online, etc. must be followed.
- At this time, wristbands and a vehicle pass are needed to enter the fairgrounds on the day of your show.

### • Rabbit & Cavy

- Arrival time for check in with Superintendent is Saturday, July 25<sup>th</sup> from 7 AM to 8 AM.
- Show begins at 9 AM, Saturday, July 25<sup>th</sup>. This will be a one-day show. Come in the morning, leave after show.
  - 4-H/FFA show shirt rule will apply.
  - Barn will be unlocked Saturday AM.
  - No exhibitors on the grounds prior to 6 AM on day of show.
  - 2020 Fair book rules will apply.
  - Superintendents will be advising where exhibitors will be placing cages.
  - Parents should bring their own chairs and practice proper social distancing
  - As of the date of this announcement the show is not open to the public, immediate family only.
  - Paper programs will not be provided. Show order will be provided possibly by QR code to download.
  - Fair will award ribbons, banners, and premiums.

- **Horse**

- Arrival time for vet check and check-in is 6 am to 8 am. Must be checked-in by and on grounds at 8 AM on Thursday, July 23, 2020.
- Show begins at 9 AM. One day show will be held Thursday, July 23, 2020.
  - The shows listed in the 2020 Fair book for Thursday and Friday will be held on Thursday, July 23rd
  - The shows listed in the 2020 Fair book for Saturday and Sunday will not be held in 2020.
  - Proper show attire as listed in the Fair book must be followed.
  - Stalls, if used, must be cleaned by the exhibitor.
  - No exhibitors on the grounds prior to 5 AM on day of show.
  - 2020 Fair book rules will apply.
  - Please park trailers north and east of the south end of horse barns as there are other shows needing space to unload and park. The pit area of the track is open for trailer parking also.
  - Parents should bring their own chairs and practice proper social distancing.
  - As of the date of this announcement the show is not open to the public, immediate family only.
  - Paper programs will not be provided. Show order will be provided possibly by QR code to download.
  - Ribbons, banners, premiums, and trophies will be awarded.
