Warren County Fair Sheep/Goat Entry & Show Rules*

version #1 dated June 11, 2020

- Entries:
 - Entries will be taken June 15, 16, 17 from Noon to 7 PM.
 - Warren County Fairgrounds—Grandstand Ticket Office—stay in your vehicle to properly social distance only getting out to come to the window to enter.
 - Entry forms and 4-H Drug Affidavit will be available at the time of entries.
 - 2020 Fair book rules still apply.
 - Fair books cannot be shared. Fair book is available online or can be purchased for \$5 at the grounds.
 - Entry fees are posted in the Fair book on page 5. (Entry Fees are non-refundable if guidelines shut down large gatherings at the end of July)
 - You will be asked at entry time how many market sheep or goat you would like to sell if an auction is available.
 - Any 4-H/FFA rules regarding YQCA, animal ID in 4-H online, etc. must be followed.
 - No Open Class Livestock.
 - No Pen of Three lamb show.

- Breeding Doe, Dairy Goat, Breeding Sheep,
 - Arrival time for vet check and check-in is Thursday, July 23rd from 6 AM to 7 AM
- Market Sheep, Market Goat
 - Arrival time for vet check and weigh-in is Thursday, July 23rd from 6 AM to 7 AM

 - Vet will inspect all Breeding and Market Sheep/Goat and Dairy Goats before unloading.
 - Market Sheep/Goat will be weighed immediately following vet inspection as unloaded off the trailer.
 - Breeding Sheep/Goat and Dairy Goat will be checked in immediately following vet inspection as they are unloaded off the trailer.
 - Tents (no sides) can be set up around sheep barn on South and East side along with West side of Hog barn. Tents (no sides) can be put up the day of show after 6 AM.
 - No exhibitors on the grounds prior to 6 AM on day of show.
 - Papers & Tattoos will be checked at check -in for Dairy Goats and Breeding Does.
 - Barn will be available Thursday at 6 AM and stalling will be after vet check in/weigh in off the trailer.
 - All sheep and goat exhibitors will use the Barn.
 - NO showing out of trailers.
 - NO stalling the night before the show. This includes tack and fans the night before the show.
 - All Livestock should be spaced 6 feet apart by family group. Superintendents will be advising.
 - Forms due at check-in at the Fair:

- 4-H Drug Affidavits
- Purebred registration papers if applicable
 - ✓ see pages 45, 47, 51 of the Fair book for registration paperwork requirements.

- Stalling:

- Superintendents will oversee stalling to maintain social distancing between family groups.
- Sheep/Goat should be spread 6' apart unless there is a family group or families that have been together.

- Show information:

- Class size will be held to maximum of 6 for social distancing.
- No color, no clipping—see 2020 Fair book for all rules.
- No Pen of Three Sheep show for 2020.
- No Rate of Gain contest due to no weigh-in.
- Trophies, banners, ribbons, and premiums will be awarded.
- Wash racks will be available
- 4H/FFA t-shirt rule applies for the show.
- There will be no show programs printed. Show programs will be posted for all to follow.
- QR codes or other means of communication will be provided.
- Depending on CDC guidelines you may be required to wear a mask for the show. BE PREPARED. Take personal responsibility. IF masks are required and you do not have one, you will not be allowed to show.
- At all times, practice social distancing.
- Use minimal bedding or use carpet. Please completely pickup and clean up your area before leaving after the show.
