

Warren County Fair

Swine Entry/Show Rules*

version #1 dated June 8, 2020

- Entries:
 - Entries will be taken June 15, 16, 17 from Noon to 7 PM.
 - Entry forms, Warren County Produced forms, 4-H Drug Affidavit will be available at the time of entries.
 - Warren County Fairgrounds—Grandstand Ticket Office—stay in your vehicle to properly social distance only getting out to come to the window.
 - Fair books cannot be shared. Fair book is available online or can be purchased for \$5 at the grounds.
 - Entry fees are posted in the Fair book on page 5. (Entry Fees are non-refundable if guidelines shut down large gatherings at the end of July)
 - You will be asked at the time of entry if you would like to sell up to 2 hogs if an auction can be made available to exhibitors.
 - You may enter up to a maximum of 6 individual pigs.
 - Maximum of 2 crossbred individual --- barrows or gilts
 - Maximum of 2 purebred individual --- barrow or gilts
 - Maximum of 2 commercial breeding gilts – either crossbred or purebred
 - Reminder: the same hog cannot be shown as a market and breeding individual.
 - The Pen of Three show has been canceled.
 - A USDA tag/photos/ear notch is needed to be displayed on 4-H online. Extension sent a very explicit letter telling what needed to be done due to the cancelation of tagging day because of the COVID19 outbreak.
 - 4-H rules regarding YQCA, animal ID in 4-H online, etc. must be followed.

- Arrival time for vet check and weigh-in: Saturday, July 25th from 6 PM to 8 PM
 - Vet will inspect all hogs before unloading.
 - Hogs will be weighed immediately following vet inspection as they are unloaded off the trailer.
 - All hogs will be weighed for class assignment.
 - Weight restriction on hogs posted in the Fair book have been waived for 2020.
 - ✓ Reason: no packer buyer is available in 2020 so all hogs sold will be going to a locker or home.
 - Do not pen hogs before vet check or weigh-in.
 - Forms due at check-in:
 - 4-H Drug Affidavits
 - Warren County Produced forms
 - Purebred registration papers if applicable
 - ✓ see page 49 of the Fair book for registration paperwork requirements
 - Exhibitors need to bring their own bedding and clean pens. Fans can be placed after stalling. You may not be stalled with your club. There will be 3 pigs per pen, please bring your own divider if you need to separate the hogs.

- Stalling:
 - Superintendents will oversee stalling to maintain social distancing between family groups.
 - Stalling will be tight due to social distancing. Bring your own dividers to divide pigs if needed.

- Show will be held Sunday, July 26th beginning at 9 am.
 - Showmanship will be held at the end of the show.
 - The Pen of Three show has been canceled.
 - Class size will be held to maximum of 6 hogs for social distancing.
 - Warren County Produced Show will be held.
 - Trophies, banners, ribbons, and premiums will be awarded.
 - Wash racks will be available
 - 4H/FFA t-shirt rule applies for the show.

- Auction (TBD)
 - All breeding hogs and non-sale hogs will need to go home immediately following the show.
 - This will be updated as more information becomes available.
