



## Covered Arena Project Details

### Covered Equestrian Arena

- 150' X 300' competition space
- 25-foot wide "porch" wraps around the competition space
- Total building is 200 feet wide by 350 feet long, resulting in 70,000 sq ft of covered (not enclosed) space
  - Judges stands, portable seating, vendors, etc can be placed at any location
  - Porch protects horse and rider from weather while waiting to compete
  - Adjacent to other arenas, livestock pens, spectator parking
- A translucent skylight panel and indirect outdoor light provide balanced visibility
- Lighting provided for night events
- The entire structure is prefabricated steel and clear-span (no posts to obscure viewing)
- Associated buildout elements include restrooms, portable bleachers, landscaping, etc
- Designed by Dawson Associates, Seattle

### Benefits

- Extend season from 5 to 9 months; adds an estimated 20 events
- Increase size of Park's largest events (currently at capacity) and offer sheltered option for activities
- Attract more disciplines that prefer/require predictable conditions such as breed shows, dressage, cutting, reining
- Support youth athletic activity
- Increase annual visitors from 30 to 50 thousand per year
- Add over \$2 million in incremental economic impact/year

### Funding to Date

- 2018: WA State Legislature Biennial Capital Budget: \$2.0 million
- 2017: Kittitas County Lodging Tax Large Capital Grant Process: \$1.5 million
- 2015: Kittitas County Sales and Use Tax Infrastructure Program for Distressed and Rural Counties: \$60 thousand (Design and Permitting)
- Private donor and corporate sponsorship funding: \$113 thousand to date
