

2020 Washington County Fair Ag Mechanics Show Rules

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Check-In: Saturday, September 12, 2020 from 12:00 until 2:00 PM at Entertainment Pavilion
Judging: Saturday, September 12, 2020 at 2:00 PM
Check-Out: Immediately after show.

Rule 1:

All Ag Mechanic entries are subject to the 2020 Rules of the Washington County Fair Ag Mechanics Show.

Rule 2:

Exhibitors must be enrolled and attending classes in Washington County ISD public, private or home schooled.

Rule 3:

A project can be exhibited only one time at the Washington County Fair. The exhibit must have been constructed, fabricated or reconditioned during the current year.

Rule 4:

All projects must be clean, painted or treated and in a presentable condition even though they may have been used.

Rule 5:

Every precaution will be taken to protect the projects entered: however, neither the WCF nor Officials of the committee will be responsible for any loss or damage to any exhibit.

Rule 6:

A working plan, blue prints, drawings or photographs showing construction and a bill of materials are required to be submitted with each project entered. These must be displayed while judging is taking place. Form is included.

Rule 7:

Once the project is entered; the project cannot be removed until it has been released from the show.

Rule 8:

Exhibitors should be dressed appropriately and be with their projects when it's judged.

The decisions of the judges as well as the announced results will be final.
