

## JUNIOR LIVESTOCK SALE - NEW BUYER REGISTRATION INFORMATION

### TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SALE

The Washington County Fair Junior Livestock Sale is designated as a "TERMINAL SALE". A Buyer's only choice of disposition is to have the project disposed of in accordance with the options listed on the Sales Sheet.

All New Buyers are subject to a **\$500 REGISTRATION FEE**. The registration fee will be applied against any sale purchase(s) or Addon Contributions initiated by the Buyer. If no purchase or Addon Contributions are made the \$500 Registration Fee will be deposited to the Washington County Fair Scholarship Fund.

**The MINIMUM Buyer split on any purchase must be at least \$500.**

Buyer(s) understands that purchases of **CARCASS HOGS** and **RABBITS** are not eligible for processing. The Buyer(s) only option is to have the Project resold and have proceeds credited against their invoice or donate the resale proceeds to a non-profit organizations listed on the Sales Ticket

Buyer(s) understands that purchases of **BROILERS** and **TURKEYS** have no resale value.

If Buyer(s) does not select an appropriate disposition option, the Project will be resold if eligible for resale and have the proceeds credited to their invoice.

A Buyer who joins another Buyer(s) to purchase a Project is responsible for entering their dollar amount of the total purchase price on the Sales Ticket/Buyer Card. If no dollar amounts are indicated each Buyer will be deemed to have elected an equal portion of the total purchase amount with no Buyer amount being less than \$500.

A Buyer who joins another Buyer(s) to purchase a Project is responsible for paying any amounts not paid by the other Buyer(s). This provision does not apply to "Add-On" amounts or "Add-On" Buyers.

**ALL SALES ARE FINAL.** A disqualification of a Project for violation of Washington County Fair Association rules will not result in a refund to the Buyer(s). Buyer(s) will receive a credit to their invoice for the resale value of the Project.

Payments not received within 60 days of receipt of 1st invoice will be subject to a 5% Late Charge
