## 2020 WCF COMMERCIAL HEIFER SALE

Welcome to the 31st annual special sale of the Commercial Heifer Division of the Washington County Fair. We are grateful for your interest and presence here. We think you will be pleased with the quality of the heifers presented before you.

This is designed to be a “no frills” sale, so please expect it to be a regular cattle sale. You will have the opportunity to purchase 422 heifers: 58 halter heifers, 116 pens of 3 and 8 pens of 2. Due to the requirement that the heifers have to be at least 60 days safe-in-calf, we lost a few along the way from the original 650 heifers that were enrolled in the program. All heifers in this sale are calfhood vaccinated.

The Washington County Fair and Commercial Heifer Committee are only the agents for the seller and have no responsibility other than those involved in conducting the sale. All heifers are palpated by licensed veterinarians. Pregnancy status stated in this sale catalog is our only guarantee the heifers are breeders. All heifers will be sold as is.

There is a resale value posted for each heifer sold. The resale value was established by a bid process. The highest bid in each class is the resale amount. Those amounts are as follows:

Fall Halters	\$ 830
Spring Halters	\$ 810

Any unsettled accounts at the end of the sale will be considered the property of the winning bidder and the heifers will not be resold.

Thank you again for coming and supporting our youth in this realistic learning experience in the cattle industry. We think you will be gratified with the quality of these cattle and please remember, this is a commercial program. These heifers should be in pasture condition to work for you when you get them home.

**The Committee asks that if you purchase heifers, please check with the front table to make arrangements for payment and pickup before leaving.** Heifers will be released for pick up on Sunday morning between 8 am and 12 pm noon. Thank you for investing your time and/or money in the future of Washington County’s youth.
