Today being final day of fair, some commercial exhibitors will want to close their booths and move out early. The pre-fair information given to exhibitors clearly states tear-down will be 1 a.m. to 2 a.m. Sunday or 9:30 a.m. to noon on Sunday. To prevent vehicles from entering the grounds tonight, the north drive-through gate will be locked at 11 p.m. and opened after fair spectators have cleared the grounds -- between midnight and 1 a.m. A key will be available in the office for emergencies.

There is another parking area available for this evening. A couple of maintenance persons should help direct parking to avoid people from parking 3 cars front to back and blocking the middle from leaving.

The Rodeo Committee barbeque is today following the afternoon performance.

The Board agreed to close the fair office on Monday, August 16, and open on Tuesday, August 17, with regular office hours 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Sprecher and Speer will be on the grounds Sunday for exhibit pick up and premium payment. All department superintendents will also be here. The Elks will be bringing in about 450 RV's for a rally the week after fair.

The Board agreed to cancel the "Friends of the Fair" Committee meeting scheduled for 7:30 a.m. Tuesday, August 17, and reschedule the meeting for Tuesday, August 24, at 7:30 a.m.

Sprecher suggested Hesse call the KYXI radio station to do a short announcement about all of today's happenings at the fair.

Next regular Fair Board meeting will be held Wednesday, September 1, 1982, at the fairgrounds office beginning at 4:30 p.m.
