Minutes of a Special Meeting Held August 27, 1975

CALL TO ORDER           A special meeting of the Fair Board was held at the Keg & Platter restaurant in Salem, Oregon, August 27, 1975 at 11:35 a.m. Notice of the meeting was publicized in the Hillsboro Argus August 26, 1975.

REASONS FOR LOCATION   The meeting was held in Salem rather than Washington County because two members of the Fair Board were exhibiting at the State Fair and could not take time to come back to Washington County.
