

August 5, 1957

The Washington County Fair Board met at 8:00 p.m. at the office on the fair grounds with all members except Mr. Abts present.

Mr. Lindow presided at the beginning of the meeting until Mr. Sahnaw arrived.

A delegation representing the Reorganized Church of Jesus Christ was present relative to the relocation of their eating establishment. No decision was made as to whether they would move it or if the fair board could move it.

Mrs. Harry O'Neel, supervisor of the Hobby Hall was present in order to find out if the hobby hall would be in order and asked if it were possible to install water after it was moved. She was informed it would probably be done.

A Mr. Henderson and Connelly representing the horse men was present complaining of the roughness of the track for horses and said their group would not be inclined to put on the Saturday night show unless this was corrected. Mr. Hockersmith who holds the contract for car racing assured them and the board that every effort would be made to correct the track.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

The secretary asked whether or not the fair board would consider hiring Lola Thomas for a month at \$200.00, beginning August 15 to September 15, since she would work and the time put in would almost equal \$200.00. Motion was made by Mr. Lindow and seconded by Mr. Ball that Lola Thomas be hired for this period at the rate of \$200.00.

Mr. L. G. Soderholm was present interested in the calf scramble which he preferred to be entered into by the 4-H and since he was donating 5 calves it was agreed to be satisfactory with the fair board. He mentioned various rules and regulations and he was asked to take it up with Joe Cox 4-H extension agent and work out the rules.

Motion was made by Mr. Lindow and seconded by Sahnaw and passed that the following bills be allowed:
