

Dec. 12, 1951.

Washington County Fair Board met in office of secretary with Mr. Abts and Mr. Guerber present as well as secretary.

Secretary reported he had investigated Farm Crops judging of Pop Corn and the judge reported he had judged Mrs. Lincoln a second prize. Mr. Abts moved to pay Mrs. Lincoln the 2nd prize, seconded by Mr. Guerber and passed.

Mr. Abts moved to allow expense of County Court and County Agent and Fair Board at Fair convention in the amount of \$48.50. Seconded by Mr. Guerber and passed.

Motion by Mr. Guerber, seconded by Mr. Abts to charge the Holstein sale \$25.00 for use of Fair buildings.

Moved by Mr. Abts, seconded by Mr. Guerber and passed that Ed Ball be employed as manager to supervise move of buildings to new Fair grounds and wrecking of other buildings at salary of \$100 per month to be adjusted later if necessary. Employment to begin Dec. 15, 1951.

Moved by Abts, seconded by Guerber and passed that employment of Vance Weatheron be terminated as of Dec. 15th and secretary instructed to give Mr. Weatheron proper notice.
