

The Washington County Fair Board met Wednesday, February 18, 1942 in the Chamber of Commerce with Mr. Guerber, Mr. Schmeltzer and Mr. Christensen present as well as the manager and secretary.

Motion made and seconded to try new system of selecting Harvest Queen candidates for 1942 fair by choosing one from each High school in county according to plan suggested by Manager Davis.

Annual election of officers was held with Mr. Christensen nominating Mr. Schmeltzer as president. Seconded and passed. Mr. Christensen then nominated Mr. Guerber as vice-president. Seconded and passed. Mr. Guerber nominated Mr. Christensen as Treasurer. Seconded and passed.

Mr. Guerber moved the election of Mrs. Leon Davis as secretary. Seconded and passed.

Mr. Christensen moved to hire Mr. Davis as manager for coming year at salary of \$300 with expense money of \$50. Seconded by Mr. Guerber and passed.
