

WASHINGTON COUNTY FAIR BOARD MEETING

THURSDAY NIGHT, February 5.

The Fair Board met in the Chamber of Commerce rooms with the following present: President H. T. Hesse, second Vice president C. D. Minton, O. H. Kraus, county school superintendent, and Ed. L. Moore, manager.

This being the night for election and re-organization of the Board the following officers were unanimously elected: R. M. Banks, president; C. D. Minton, first vice-president; H. T. Hesse, second vice-president; O. B. Kraus, treasurer.

By motion carried unanimously Ed. L. Moore was appointed secretary-manager. By motion carried unanimously his salary was to be \$200.00 per year, and an allowance of \$.07 per mile for all auto trips in the interest of the Fair.

By a motion unanimously carried the dates of the Fair for this year were set for September 10, 11, and 12. H.T. Hesse reported on meeting with the Pomona Grange, and stated that the Grangers were favorable to a Grange Day and program, but objected to the noise on the grounds near the auditorium during their program. Mr. Minton suggested that, at a late meeting, all masters of Granges of Washington County be invited to meet with the Fair Board for discussion of Grange Day.

The next meeting was to be held in the Chamber of Commerce rooms Thursday night, February 19, at 7:30 members of the Fair Board and all the superintendents were to be invited to attend.
