

July 2, 1951

Meeting of the Fair Board called to order at 10:30 A.M. by Elmer Guerber, president. Others present included Clayton Nyberg, vice president; A.H. Abts, treasurer and Leon S. Davis secretary.

Meeting called to consider manager. Board called on Floyd McDonald and discussed the managership with him briefly. He asked for more time to consider but told the Board that if there was anyone else to pass him up.

The Board then met with Vance Weatherton, former secretary of Hillsboro Chamber of Commerce.

Motion made by Abts, seconded by Nyberg, that Weatherton be employed at a salary of \$400 for the remainder of the year, and that he be granted 6 cents per mile for expenses during the remainder of the year. Passed.

Conditions in the school exhibit buildings were discussed by the secretary and a suggestion made that something be done to the floor to eliminate the dust.

Motion made by Abts that the floor be black topped if the job be done at a reasonable cost. Seconded by Nyberg and passed.
