The Washington County Fair Board met at the office on the fair grounds with everyone present, except Ball and Hansen.

Miss Swedberg of the county extension department was present with a group from the County Extension Units relative to seeing what might be done toward paving the floor of the 4-H building. They were given the authority to see just what they might do in raising the necessary funds.

Beaverton Grange representatives were present asking if it might not be advisable to have the granges all follow or build their booths according to a standard form. Nothing definite was decided on this since it was felt the recommendation should come from all the granges if they wished to follow a set-pattern in their booths.

Dick Bond of Permapost Products was present asking if their firm might put up a rest shelter, and presented a very attractive picture, size 12' x 12' and he was given permission to do this and the fair board agreed to stake a place near the existing drinking fountain. Mr. Bond also inquired into replacing the fence and posts which matter was tabled until a later date.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.
