Dear Mrs Hadley:

Your letter of May 11th at hand wherein you request that the Fair Board stand half of the amount due for monies advanced for state retirement and social security payments by Washington County. I have just been advised that Governor Patterson has signed House Bill 406, I believe is the number, which makes it mandatory that the County Court levy up to $\frac{1}{4}$ mill on all taxable property in the county for county fair funds. Having an emergency clause on the bill will allow us to get it in this new budget and I believe this will do away with all of our troubles in this tax withholding mixup.


