This special meeting was called to outline a 5 year plan to present to the commissioners. Present were Adams, Jossy, Gardner, Holt, Lindow, Shearer and John Guyer.

Plans and costs were discussed.

It was agreed the first thing that must be done is to get the drainage and sewage problems solved before any other plans could be finalized. Mr. Jossy will attend the budget hearing and present the following:

To be included in the 1969-70 budget would be \$15,000 for sewage and \$10,000 for drainage. This would initiate the drainage around the buildings and made so that it could be hooked into as money is available.

Future plans call for:

1. Expo center - 300 x 300x - \$1,000,000.00
2. Complete the 4-H Dorm building - \$48,000.00
3. Horse training track - \$10,000

These are the facilities that have been asked for by the people of the County. There are undoubtedly many others that there is need for but future plans and conditions will bring them out.

It was agreed that the gas bill be paid.

As there was no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 1:15 p.m.
