To the Honorable County Court,
Washington County, Oregon.

Gentlemen:

Following is the resolution passed at the meeting of
the County Fair Board Thursday evening, March 24, 1932:

Owing to the non-appropriation by the tax levying
committee of assistance for the County Fair it is decided
not to hold a County Fair in Washington County for the
year 1932; that the one-twentieth of a mill of premium
money paid to the Court by the State for County Fair
purposes, industrial exhibitions and other shows be
divided as the Board deems best as premiums to the 4H Clubs
for community expositions, and for additional premiums
won by Washington County exhibit at the Oregon State Fair,
and the Manufacturers and Land Products show at the
Pacific International Livestock Exposition, and to the
Corn and Potato Show held at Hillsboro.

All subject to the approval of the County Court.
