Motion made by Abts and seconded by Guerber that H. Mohr be authorized to concentrate the facilities at the new grounds to the best interests of the public. Motion carried.

A representation from Timber Structures were present, however, since the contract had already been let there was no further consideration.

Present at the meeting were Guerber, Nyberg Abts and manager Ball.

There being no further business upon motion made and seconded, the meeting adjourned.
