

May 26, 1943.

Washington County Fair Board met May 26, 1943 in the Commercial National Bank with all members present including the secretary. Mr. Svinth, county 4-H leader and Mr. Thomas of the F.F.A. also attended to discuss plans for the Fair.

Mr. Thomas reported the F.F.A. had more exhibits in view for the fair than last year. Mr. Svinth reported the boys 4-H enrollment increased 30% over last year and the girl's 4-H have 900 enrolled this year against 800 last year.

A motion was made by Mr. Schmeltzer to hold a Junior Fair September 3-4, 1943. Seconded and passed.

Motion made by Mr. Christensen, seconded and passed to have the premium list printed including the following additions and changes:

Motion made by Mr. Guerber and seconded and passed to cover increase of boys 4-H and F.F.A. as premiums listed.

Motion made to allow Fiss Nichols to adjust girls 4-H premium list if necessary to the amount of a \$15 increase. Passed.

Mr. Christensen reported the purchase of the property voted at the last meeting as completed and all necessary papers filed and recorded.

It was suggested inquiry be made if county prisoners could be employed in preparing the fair buildings for the fair.
