

The Washington County Fair Board met Friday evening, Oct. 10, 1941 in the Chamber of Commerce with Mr. Guerber, Mr. Schmeltzer and Mr. Christensen present as well as the manager and secretary.

The manager produced a 1940 warrant belonging to Mr. Roseman and requested a motion regarding the same. Mr. Schmeltzer moved it be paid if and when we have 50% in funds and the matter be left to the manager. Seconded by Mr. Christensen and passed.

Manager also produced a bill for 4 bales of straw bought by Geo. Hermens of the Valley Feed Store inc. and asked for a motion regarding same. Mr. Christensen moved we pay the bill and Mr. Schmeltzer seconded it. Passed.

Motion made by Mr. Schmeltzer to borrow \$1525 from the Commercial National Bank to pay construction bills, said amount to be repaid from county budget for Washington County Fair. Seconded by Mr. Christensen and passed. Copy of this motion to be furnished bank also.

Motion made by Mr. Schmeltzer to invite all Washington County schools manual arts departments to participate in Fair exhibits in 1942. Seconded by Mr. Christensen and passed.
