

October 22, 1958

The Washington County Fair Board met in the conference room of the County Agents office in the court house with all members present.

Robert Hockersmith who holds the contract with the fair board for hot-rod racing at the fair grounds was present; also, Jim Anderson of the First National Bank was present relative to trying to work out a definite plan of payment towards the retirement of loan held by the Bank towards the building of the grandstand which was contracted under Ruecker and Wilson, original holders of the contract, through security of private subscription to the bank. The matter was discussed and Hockersmith felt he could pay \$500.00 yearly on this note. The fair board took the view that the grandstand was the property of the county and an asset to the fairgrounds, however it was felt that a check with the auditor should be made relative to contributing payment on this debt which might jeopardize our source of revenue from the racing funds. Mr. Abts was asked to look into the matter.

Motion was made by Mr. Lindow, seconded by Mr. Abts and carried that the following bills be allowed:
