

MEETING OF FAIR BOARD DIRECTORS

AND

THE COUNTY COURT.

SEPTEMBER 9, 1933.

The Washington County Fair Board met with the County Court at the Blue Eagle Cafe Saturday noon, September 9, 1933, President H. T. Hesse presiding.

There were present - H. T. Hesse, C. D. Minton, County Judge Don Templeton, Commissioner Kirkman and Mrs. Moore, secretary protem.

Judge Templeton reported that he had received a warrant for a little over \$600.00 from the dog racing fund.

This meeting was called to consider the request of the 4H Club leaders to allow them the sum of \$200.00 from the dog racing fund. The 4H Club was in arrears on their Fair in the sum of \$157.13, and they also wished 50.00 to defray the expense of getting their exhibits to the State Fair.

After discussion it was moved by Judge Templeton, seconded by Mr. Minton, that the request of the 4H Club for \$200.00 be denied. Motion carried.

Mr. Minton reported that two checks, given for insurance, had been taken from the premium money. Judge Templeton stated that he would see that these checks were transferred and taken out of the general fund.

The secretary reported that the balance on hand at the time of the closing of the Shute Bank was \$84.61. 15% of this amount had been placed in the First National Bank of Portland, Hillsboro branch, leaving a balance in that fund of \$71.92, making the amount on hand in the general fund \$12.69.

President Hesse made a report of the request of the Granges for \$400.00 for their Grange booths at the 4H Club Fair, and he stated he had told them they would be allowed \$50.00 each if they had 8 grange booths. There were seven Grange booths at the Fair. Moved by Mr. Minton, seconded by Judge Templeton, that warrants be drawn in the amount of \$50.00 for each of the Granges that exhibited at the 4H Club Fair. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Minton, seconded, that R. M. Banks be made treasurer of the Washington County Fair Board for the coming year, and the secretary instructed to have the books and vouchers turned over to Mr. Banks, after being audited. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Minton, seconded by Judge Templeton, that the treasurer be instructed to deposit the funds of the County Fair with the First National Bank of Portland, Hillsboro Branch. Motion carried.

Upon motion the meeting adjourned.
