## Fair Waiver Form

Participants must recognize that all classes/activities of a physical nature involve some risk and by registering for the mud volleyball tournament there is an assumption of risk by the participant. # Washington county Fair Mud Volleyball Tournament

## Tournament Rules

- 1)** The tournament will be double elimination and limited to 24 teams.
- 2)** Team fee is \$60.00. All teams MUST be registered by Wednesday, July 24th, enabling us to have preliminary brackets available the Friday of fair week. Sooner you pay the earlier you play. NO REGISTRATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED THE DAY OF THE TOURAMENT!!!
- 3)** A team shall consist of 6 players (3 male and 3 female players).
- 4)** The tournament will start at 10 am. The tournament will utilize 6 courts.
- 5)** A game shall consist of the first team to 25. Must win by 2.
- 6)** Rally scoring is in effect for the entire tournament.
- 7)** All team members must read and sign a release waiver prior to play. Any substitutions must sign a waiver as well.
- 8)** No fighting. Any individual fighting will be removed from the premises. Their team will be disqualified and also asked to leave.
- 9)** Players are strongly advised to wear old clothing. You will be in sand & mud.
- 10)** Shoes are recommended. The organizers and property owners are not liable for any injuries due to players being barefoot.
- 11)** Individuals participate at their own risk.
- 12)** Teams are advised to be present 15 minutes before the start of their game to keep the tournament running on schedule. If the team is not present within 5 minutes of game time you will forfeit.
- 13)** Teams make their own calls. If the other team disputes a call and resolution cannot be made, serve will be replayed.
- 14)** Officials will not be provided.
- 15)** Rock, paper, scissors will determine the first serve.
- 16)** All standard front and back row player rules apply. (You may not bring guys up to block.)
- 17)** Each serve shall continue until a "side out" is called.
- 18)** If a player serves out of turn, side out shall be called as soon as the mistake is discovered. Any points made on his/her service before the error will be reversed.
- 19)** It is illegal to block/spike a serve. If a serve is blocked/spiked the serving team will receive a point.

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## **20) Point:**

- a. Fail to return the ball legally to opponent's court.
- b. Server intentionally serves before the receiving team is ready to play.
- c. Illegal serves. After 3 points with overhand serve you MUST serve underhand.
- d. Catch the ball.
- e. Hold the ball (scooping, lifting, shoving shall be considered as holding).
- f. Strike the ball more than once in succession.
- g. Be the 4th player to play the ball (except when it has been a simultaneous hit).
- h. Touch the net with any part of the body at any time while the ball is in play.
- i. Reach under the net and touch the ball or a player of the opposing team when the ball is in play on that side or interfere with the play of the opposing team.
- j. A double foul shall be called when players on opposing teams commit a foul.

**21)** Each team gets one timeout per match. The timeout shall not exceed one minute. Timeouts may be requested at any time by the captain while the ball is dead.

**22)** Blocking a ball, which is entirely on the opponent's side of the net, is permitted when the opposing team has had an opportunity to complete its attack.

**23)** A ball that contacts water is in, i.e. if it makes a splash it is in.

**24)** If only one player is attempting to block and in doing so contacts the ball, he/she is permitted to contact it a second time.

**25)** Multiple contacts of the ball or touches by a player during one play of the ball: When a ball rebounds from one part of the player's body to another in one attempt to save a hard driven spike not already touched by a team-mate, it is a legal multiple contact and considered one hit. When a ball rebounds from one part of a player's body to another in one attempt to block, it is a legal multiple contact and the team's next play is considered its first hit.

**26)** Guy/girl rule, a girl must hit the ball at least once before it goes over the net unless there are less than 2 total hits.

**27)** No drinking of alcoholic beverages on Fair Ground property outside the beer garden area. The beer garden will open at 10:00 a.m. Any team caught drinking outside the beer garden/volleyball area will be disqualified from the tournament. NO COOLERS ALLOWED!

**28)** Prize for first place is T-Shirts.
