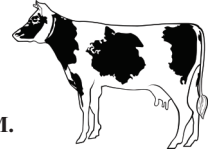

Animal Health Regulations

IMPORTANT: ALL HEALTH PAPERS MUST BE CHECKED BEFORE UNLOADING. Cattle for exhibition require a CVI dated after May 1 of the current exhibition year, Ear Tagging compliance, and a current rabies vaccination (market animals exempt).
