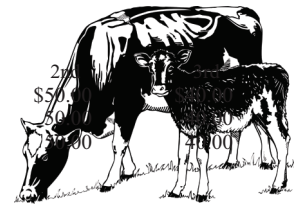

**IMPORTANT: ALL HEALTH PAPERS MUST BE CHECKED BEFORE UNLOADING. Sheep for exhibition require a CVI dated after May 1 of the current exhibition year, Scrapies compliance, and a current rabies vaccination.**
