1. All 4-H exhibits for the West End Fair are listed in this section.
2. All entries are limited to members of organized 4-H clubs in Monroe County under the supervision of the Penn State Cooperative Extension.
3. Unless otherwise indicated, all exhibits must come from a 4-H project in which the exhibitor was officially enrolled with the Cooperative Extension Office by July 1 of the current year.
4. Club members must have passed their eighth birthday but not have passed their nineteenth birthday by January 1 of the current year.
5. Exhibitors may not compete against themselves in any class.
6. All entries must have been made by the member since last year's fair.
7. All exhibits must be the work of an individual member unless the category specifies that it is a club entry.
8. There is a maximum of 25 entries in this department.
9. It is recommended that all poster entries be 14"x22" (this is the required PA Farm Show size).
10. Displays: 3 Dimensional and free standing (if applicable)
11. Clover buds can only enter exhibits under Section A-33.
12. When a project book is used for more than one year, list on the book cover what pages have been completed in the current year (for example: some animal care and nutrition projects).
13. NOTE: All animal entries and classes must be preregistered by July 18 with the West End Fair Association.
14. **All animal entries are subject to the West End Fair Association health guidelines and requirements.**
15. **Proper attire required for judging – closed toe shoes, long pants and collared shirts.**
16. **All entries MUST be registered with Extension Office by July 18.**

Section 1
Dairy Cattle

1. All dairy animals must be accompanied with health charts.
2. Members must be present and have charge of their animals at time of judging.
3. Each member will be allowed to show one animal per class.
4. The following classes and premiums shall apply to each of the six major dairy breeds.
1 - Ayrshire 2 - Brown Swiss 3 - Guernsey 4 - Holstein 5 - Jersey 6 - Milking Shorthorn
