- *Beer must be in 12 oz. bottles
- *Wine entered for competition must be amateur wine, home produced under Regulations of Part 540 of the Code of Federal Regulations.
- *All wines will be evaluated by professional judges. A rating sheet will be mailed to each exhibitor showing, in detail, how the wine was judged.
- *Wine may be from any year's grapes. All bottles must be labeled with the year. Once the wine has been entered, it cannot then be entered again in a subsequent year.
- *No transportation of Federal Registration is required.
