

HOW TO ENTER

- 1 Complete the proper entry form(s) and mail it to: West End Fair, P.O. Box 115, Gilbert, PA 18331
- 2 One form per person, along with \$4.00 per person, should accompany entry form for all departments.
- 3 Items to be entered in Livestock - REGISTERED BY JULY 23. Livestock check in on August 17, SATURDAY 2 - 4 P.M., AUGUST 18, between 10 A.M. AND 4 P.M.
- 4 Items to be entered in 4H - REGISTERED BY JULY 18. DELIVERED TO FAIR GROUNDS SATURDAY, AUGUST 17, 2 - 4 P.M.
- 5 Items to be entered in Departments 11-19, 21, 22, 23 - REGISTERED BY JULY 23. DELIVERED TO FAIR GROUNDS SATURDAY, AUGUST 17, 9 A.M.-5 P.M.
- 6 Pick up of items entered is on SUNDAY, AUGUST 25 FROM 10A.AM. - NOON.

Take items to appropriate department. Entry tags will be in department area.

ENTRY FORM: Complete all information requested to ensure accurate entry of exhibits. Locate an accurate description of your entry under the proper Department listing in the premium guide. Record the Department number, Section number, class number and descriptive wording as shown. In many instances you will want to enter exhibits of anticipated production (i.e. flower, crops, projects near completion, etc.). These types of entries are to be included on the entry form. It is understood you are not always able to exhibit some of these items because of the “unpredictability” and there is no penalty if the item is not exhibited. Up to 25 items per Department may be listed on the entry form. Exhibitors may enter one item per class. Be sure to review the GENERAL RULES and the Special Information at the beginning of each Department.

Do not hesitate to contact the West End Fair for assistance. Entries not classified correctly on the Entry Form will be disqualified.

Dear Exhibitor,

The West End Fair is fast approaching and we hope you have started to think about what you might like to enter. Fair week will run August 18 through August 24. We have added a few new contests and with the feedback we received and are continuing a couple that we tried last year. We have also decided to move some of the locations of the departments to give more space for the entries.

Department 10- 4H (including the 4H small animals) will be located in what was the group and school building

Department 11- School Exhibits will move to where Hay & Grain were in the Exhibit #2 building

Department 12- Hay & Grain will now be in a huge tent with Farmer for the Day. This is across from Exhibit #2 building

Department 20- Groups will move to where 4H was. (down by the grand stand)

As in the past, all exhibitors must pre-register the items they wish to display by **July 23 for Departments 1-9 and Departments 11-23**. Department 10 must register to the Cooperative Extension by July 18. Items then will be brought to the fairgrounds for Department 11-23 exhibits on Saturday, August 17 from 9 AM – 5PM. Department 10 from 12-4PM. Departments 1- 9 can bring their animals in Saturday 2PM- 4PM and Sunday 10AM -4PM. Please make sure you give yourself enough time on entry day if you will be bringing many items.

Enclosed is a pre-registration form for Department 11 – 23. Exhibitors must refer to a current premium listing when filling out the form. You can review the fair book online and find more forms at www.thewestendfair.com or obtain a fair book from one of the local businesses in the area. The item you are wishing to enter must be listed in the book. If we currently do not have something you may suggest it be added for the following year.

Once the fair is over you may pick up your items on Sunday, August 25 from 10AM to noon. Checks will be mailed the following week.
