

The WFA Hall of Fame award honors distinguished achievement or outstanding contribution by an individual to the fair industry.

### Selection

Selection of the recipient(s) of the Hall of Fame Award is made solely by the WFA Board of Governors. The Board of Governors reviews all recommendations and may identify additional individuals for consideration. The WFA Board of Governors is not required to select a recipient each year.

### Conditions of Eligibility

The candidate shall have been identified with the fair industry for a minimum of ten years; have shown substantial contributions to the industry through leadership, education, legislation, technical service and/or outstanding service to the associated industries and organizations serving the fair industry; and have shown active participation (past or present) in Western Fairs Association. This award may be presented posthumously.
