

2020 WCYF Plan of Action

Pending the updated governmental guidelines to be released April 3, 2020.

Plan A

- Proceed to have all market shows and high point creative arts that are eligible for sale of excellence consideration
- Schedule and location of shows are subject to change
- All scheduled shows for the day will take place and animals will be dismissed from the grounds the same day
- Attendance is depending on county/governmental guidelines at the scheduled dates of the fair, more than likely gates will not be open to the public
- In some cases showmanship may or may not take place. Showmanship will be judged while livestock are being shown, there will not be a separate showmanship show
- We are still working on the 2020 WCYF Sale of Excellence plan

Plan B (If Government continues to limit gatherings to 10 people or less)

- All livestock will be dropped off at a scheduled time
- Only designated personnel will be allowed to stay on the grounds or show facility
- Schedule and location of shows are subject to change
- Livestock will be evaluated by a judge similar to a livestock judging event or best possible way
- Livestock that are required to be broken down in to classes will be and judged accordingly
- Once livestock are evaluated and placed, all livestock will leave the WCYF or show facility
- A Grand and Reserve Champion will be announced and other placings will be posted
- No showmanship will take place
- We are still working on the 2020 WCYF Sale of Excellence plan

Plan C (Worst case scenario)

- WCYF is completely cancelled
- All exhibitors entered in the 2020 WCYF, who were to be evaluated for SOE consideration, will receive a Lot # and be eligible for 2020 WCYF Sale of Excellence
