- 5. No person may enter more than one entry in any one class.
- Placing will be awarded on the decisions of the judge. Judges will not be required to award places unless the quality of the entry is deserving of recognition.
- Entry will be by photo. One photo of each entry, unless stated in the specific Division Rules below. Photo should 7. include a ruler or measuring tape next to the entry to provide size and proportions of the entry for judging.

To Enter:

- 1. Review the Divisions and Classes available for youth entry this year. Some Classes have been eliminated or combined for the 2020 fair online entry only. New Pandemic 2020 only classes added.
- 2. Make and gather your entries for the classes you plan to enter.
- 3. Take a photo of each entry- one item/class per photo. Each photo should have a measuring instrument (ruler, measuring tape, etc.) in the photo to provide scale (unless noted- such as the Photography Divisions).
- 4. Go the Fair website: https://www.williamsoncountyfair.org/ between July 1-July 30, 2020 and follow the link for entry in the correct age group-10 & Under or Youth (completed 4th-12th grade). The entry system will not be live or available before July 1st.
- 5. Complete the entry form- one child at a time, select the divisions and classes you are entering and upload the correct photo to the correct division and class. If more than one child in the home is entering, please complete a separate form for each child. The Family classes will have their own entry form, one entry form per family/household for Family classes.
- 6. Once you have uploaded all photos for the classes you plan to enter, click submit.
- 7. Judging will take place online following the July 30th deadline. Winners will be announced on the Williamson County Fair website by August 7, 2020.
- 8. No awards will be presented in 2020, but winners will be posted online.
