4-H & Youth Village - \$25,000

The 4-H & Youth Village has quickly become a crowd favorite at the Williamson County Fair. Children and adults alike are able to participate in live contests, free hands on activities, STEM activities, and so much more! This interactive area features lots of fun and exciting things to do. Whether it's wood working, building a popsicle bridge or learning about bugs, just to name a few, this is an area that the whole family is sure to enjoy. You can check out the winners of the 4-H & Youth competitive events too!



Agriculture Exhibit - \$2,500

Located on the west end of the mezzanine in the indoor arena all Country Hams, Horticulture, Field Crops, and Honey & Bees entries are on display, along with all the winning entries. Also located in this area are the Century Farms Exhibit, Pick TN Products Exhibit and Master Gardener's Exhibit.



BMX Trickstars - \$25,000

An annual favorite, this team has a lineup of talent that reaches as high as a Gold Medal. They are class acts on and off the stage. It's amazing to see them perform as they pull off tricks that many would consider impossible. What they can do on their bikes is amazing! It's a must-see show...and generally has some of the largest crowds on those summer nights. 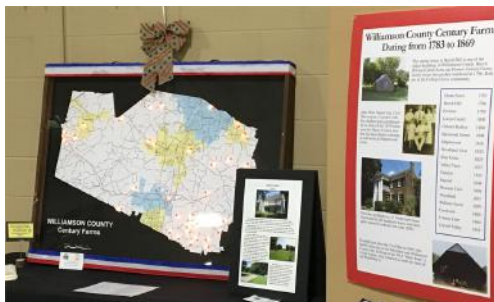
Bleacher Seat Wraps - \$15,000

Century Farms Exhibit & Dinner - \$5,000

The Williamson County Fair honors our counties Century Farms with an exhibit and dinner each year. The exhibit educates fairgoers on the significance of these special farms by sharing photos and information on each farm and family. There are currently 37 Century Farms in Williamson County.



Chainsaw Artist - \$15,000

Roark Phillips creates sculptures right before your eyes! From grizzly bears & soaring eagles to custom signs & one-of-a-kind wooden benches. Roark uses chainsaws and logs in all sizes to create these amazing works of art! With one cut at a time he transforms multiple carvings throughout the week, and many are available for purchase. See the transformation of a simple log into a unique piece of art!



Children's Barnyard - \$20,000

Kids love playing in the corn pit, or they can pet a mama llama, try their hand at roping a (fake) steer, or pet a miniature donkey. We have lots of farm animals in the barnyard for Fair visitors to see...sheep, goats, Shetland pony, beef and dairy cattle, draft horse, alpaca, pygmy goats, a Texas Longhorn, and more. Also located in the barnyard are the Birthing Pig Exhibit and the Duck Slide.



Creative & Culinary Arts Room - \$10,000

Creative & Culinary Arts entries and winners are on display in the Creative & Culinary Arts Room. Quilts, Textiles, Fairy Gardens, Handicrafts, Needlework, Canned Goods, Breads, Cakes, Candy, Cookies, Pies and more are on display for all to enjoy!



Cultural Arts Exhibit - \$7,500

The Cultural Arts Exhibit showcases incredible talent in Fine Arts, Photography, Film and Songwriting. All winning pieces are on display throughout the fair.



Duck Slide - \$2,500

Watch the “cute as a button” baby ducks slide down a slide in the Children’s Barnyard...over and over again. A true crowd favorite!



Elevator Doors - \$5,000

The elevator doors located on the mezzanine just as you come through the main entrance of the arena could wear your company logo/advertisement on the inside and out. Every family with a stroller will use this elevator many times during the nine-day event as they go down to the arena floor and back up again. It is also highly visible due to its location and is the only elevator in the building.

Little 1's Farming - \$25,000

Our signature event...Little 1's Farming has become a family favorite for our Fair visitors. Become a farmer for a while – plant seeds, milk our cow “Buttercup”, harvest your crop, sell your goods and “spend” your proceeds on a delicious snack. A hands-on hit with children of all ages!



Livestock Show Ring - \$10,000

Located in Barn “B”, this centrally located barn is open to the fair going public to watch competitive livestock shows as they happen. Shows include, beef cattle, dairy cattle, dairy goats, market goats, commercial ewes, market lambs, and mule shows and pulls, as well as the 4-H Expo live auction.



Livestock Stage - \$2,500

Featuring a variety of talent performing between the various livestock shows, the Livestock Stage is located in Barn “B”.



Livestock Village - \$20,000

Naming rights for the Livestock Village, which includes our premiere Little 1's Farming Exhibit and Children's Barnyard. Also, the location of all Williamson County 4-H, Open and Junior livestock competitions, as well as the 4-H Livestock Expo & Sale.



Milking Parlor - \$2,500

LIVE milking demonstrations are performed nightly in the Milking Parlor. Fair patrons are offered the opportunity to learn more about how the milk in their fridge is produced by dairy cows, and about the farmers who care for them.



On-line Ticket Ad - \$5,000

In 2018, our third year of on-line ticket sales, we sold over 6,000 individual and ticket packages. These pre-sale tickets are printed or shown on a phone for scanning at the ticket gate. All tickets may be printed for use of a coupon, which will drive business to your store or location. Tickets will have your company name, logo and coupon/ad located on the top right corner of the page.



Pageants - \$10,000

Pageants are a highlight of most traditional Fairs, and the Williamson County Fair Pageant system helps young women across Williamson County set goals for themselves and gives them confidence to achieve their dreams. Girls from babies to 20 years of age, and baby/toddler boys are encouraged to participate to help build self-esteem, confidence, and poise, as well as self-discipline and character. Contests include Baby/Toddler Miss & Mister, Petite Miss, Little Miss, Junior Miss, Teen Miss, and Fairest of the Fair. The winner of the Fairest of the Fair competition represents Williamson County in the State Fairest of the Fair competition.



Patriot Day - \$7,500

All active and retired military individuals are admitted FREE with military ID on the last Saturday of the Fair. Show your patriotic pride by having your business name on this day.



Phone Charging Stations - \$2,500 each

Phone charging stations located in the Picnic Pavilion and on the Arena Floor to offer patrons the ability to charge their phones for free, while allowing your company to advertise on the screen.



Picnic Pavilion - \$5,000

Located indoors on the east end of the mezzanine, the Picnic Pavilion offers an area inside the air-conditioned arena for fair goers to enjoy their "fair food". The pavilion is also used for several special events and competitive events throughout the 9 days of the fair, and before.



Pogo Stick Show - \$25,000

The Xpogo Stunt Team is the best extreme pogo performance team in the world. Jumping over 9 feet in the air on next-generation pogo sticks while throwing down flips and incredible tricks. An amazing high energy show...exciting until the final bounce!



Robocars Strolling Act (4) - \$15,000

As seen on Shark Tank, American Idol and Let's Make a Deal, this strolling entertainment act is a huge fan favorite as children smile with delight as these action figures transform into fast action wheels right before your eyes. Vocal Competition - \$5,000

“Sing Your Heart Out” vocal competition offers Elementary, Middle, and High School students an opportunity to compete for cash prizes, with the Overall Winner receiving an addition \$500 and other prizes.



Volunteer Appreciation Dinner - \$5,000

The Volunteer Appreciation Dinner is held the night before opening day as a kick off to the Fair each year. Of the numerous volunteers that it takes to make the Fair happen, around 300 attend the dinner each year in the Picnic Pavilion located in the air-conditioned arena. The dinner also offers our Fair Chairman an opportunity to thank the hundreds of volunteers who dedicate tremendous efforts to make the Fair a success. Volunteer Lounge - \$5,000

Available to all who volunteer throughout the nine days of the Fair. Snacks, water and food provided.

Volunteer T-shirts - \$2,500
