

- 16. For the protection of exhibitors, No Entries will be removed on the Closing Night of the Fair.
- 17. Prize Money is paid only in accordance with results recorded into the online program.

 Tags, ribbons, etc. have no value as to payment of Prize Money.
- 18. The Fair Management shall not be responsible for accidents or losses that may occur to any of the exhibitors or exhibits at the Fair. The exhibitor (or parent or guardian of a minor) is responsible for any injury or damage resulting from the exhibitor's participation in the program or event. This included any injury to others or to the exhibitor or to the exhibitor's property.
- 19. Proper precautions will be taken for the protection of the exhibits, but Yolo County Fair or its representatives will not be responsible for loss by fire, theft or otherwise.
- 20. The Exhibitor agrees to indemnify and save harmless Association and the State of California, their officers, servants and employees from any and all claims, resulting from any damages, injury or loss to any person or persons, including all persons to whom the Exhibitor may be liable under any Worker's Compensation law and Exhibitor himself and from any loss, damage, cause of action, claims or suits for damages including, but not limited to, loss of property, goods, caused by, arising out of or in any way connected with the exercise by Exhibitor of the privileges herein granted.

Notes:
