Campers/vehicles without passes will not be allowed in the campground and are subject to fines/towing if parked in the campground. Please read the following guidelines carefully:

- Chaperones must be at least 21 years of age by January 1st of the Fair year to register a camper with the fair. No chaperone will be responsible for more than 10 youth exhibitors. There must be an adult staying in each camper.
- Chaperones are responsible for the actions of all persons staying in the camper.
- By signing, applicant agrees to act in a respectable and responsible manner and abide by the Fond du Lac Agricultural Society Code of Ethics and agrees that they will be responsible for all staying in his or her camper. If any disciplinary problems occur, the Fair Disciplinary Action Guidelines will be enforced. Applicant/Chaperone agrees to follow all rules and regulations set forth by the Fond du Lac Agricultural Society, the Superintendents, the Adult Supervisors, and the Sheriff's Department. Quiet time will be from 12:00 a.m. until 6:00 a.m.
