## Tango Mandarin

The Tango mandarin is a variety developed by irradiating the budwood of another mandarin variety called W. Murcott. Fruit size is considered moderately large for a mandarin approximately 2.3 inches in diameter and is considered a low seeded mandarin. Fruit mature in December to January. Peel color at maturity is a deep

orange with a very smooth rind. Fruit are deeply oblate in shape and moderately large in size. Fruit are juicy, sweet and easy to peel. Trees have an upright growth habit and produce fruit very early.
