PATROL BOATS NEEDED!



VOLUNTEER FOR SEAFAIR WEEKEND - AUGUST 2-5, 2017

General Requirements: All Skippers must be at least 21 years of age and have their Boaters license if applicable. Crew must be over the age of 16 years and experienced in boating. Size of boat, style, and openings available will determine location of patrol area on lake. Skippers will need to enlist their own crew.

Log boom & Shore Patrol: Volunteer Skippers patrol the shore, log booms and lake entrances into the hydroplane course area; maintaining the safety of the spectators and our performers. Patrolling starts on Thursday and goes through Sunday. Volunteers must sign-up for at least two of these days. **Power boats under 30' preferred.**

Course Construction Boats: Assist in setting up and maintaining the race course working with divers. Set up starts July 8th and continues every Saturday-Sunday and through race weekend. Course is taken down Sunday August 5th - Monday Aug. 6th. **Any size power boat is needed.**

Course Boats: Course boats are in the middle of the race course and assist towing in hydroplanes to shore if needed. Skipper must be experienced handling their boat and with the capability to tow a hydro that may be partially submerged. **Power boats approximately 27'-35'.**

Shuttle Boats: Skippers are assigned to shuttle authorized people between the Communication Tower on shore to the docks in the pits. In addition selected shuttle boats will take credentialed media to different locations on the lake. **Power boats 18'-30'. May need larger for certain VIP tours.**

Docks & Boom Set-up/Tear-down Boats and Crew: Team members manage the placement of docks, floats & barges used for the race. Skippers will assist Docks team to maneuver floating docks into position, take members to floats in lake, assist in assembly of docks and light set-up on boom. This position usually starts the week prior to Race weekend. Prefer boats that can push, pull, and haul. Dock hands should feel comfortable balancing on floating docks, stand, bend-over and kneel, and handle common construction tools. The bulk of the work is done before and after the event so you have lots of time to enjoy the full event. **Looking for tuff working boats.**

Dock Hands: Assist in tying up boats and load/unload people. Assist where needed. Must be able to sit, stand, bend, lift, reach, step, climb, run, walk, kneel or whatever is needed to perform a wide range of tasks, on land and on water in all weather conditions.

COMPENSATION: T-shirt (if registered and approved before June 15th), family passes, bottled water, and fuel for boat if needed. (depending on hours worked and total fuel available). Also there is an Volunteer picnic for volunteers and their family Wednesday night at Stan Sayres Park prior to the festival weekend. A Volunteer Appreciation Dinner is also held near the end of August.
