Please read important information in the front section of this book.

- All entries must be the work of the exhibitor, completed between September, 2019 and September, 2020.
- A quilt pieced by one person and quilted by another or by a quilting service must be entered in a “Quilted by Another” class.
- The judge will have the right not to award a first place ribbon/award if the item does not merit the placing.
- Awards in any class will be given only if merited.
- There shall not be more than one ribbon awarded and one award paid for each placement in a class.
- **A 4” sleeve is required on all quilts wider than 60”.**

AWARDS

Blue Rosette	\$25.00	First place within a particular class.
Red Rosette	\$15.00	Second place within a particular class.
White Rosette	\$10.00	Third place within a particular class.
Best of Show	Rosette	This award represents the best entry within this subdepartment that has placed “First” in a given class within this subdepartment.
Judge’s Choice	Rosette	This award represents the “judge’s choice” within each category.

QUILTING

CLASS

- FF001 Bed Quilts, Appliqued or Mixed Techniques (can be appliqued with embellishments, pieced & appliqued, pieced with embellishments, any combination)
- FF002 Bed Quilts, Pieced
- FF003 Throw-size Quilts (larger than wall quilts, smaller than bed, any technique)
- FF004 SMALL - Quilted by Another - majority of work done by maker but hand or machine quilting done by another. Perimeter 250 inches or less
- FF005 LARGE - Quilted by Another - majority of work done by maker but hand or machine quilting done by another. Perimeter greater than 250 inches
- FF006 Lullaby Quilts
- FF007 Miniature (a scaled down quilt design with a perimeter less than 100 inches)
- FF008 Other Techniques (embroidered, whole-cloth, candlewicking, ragged-edge, yo-yo, etc.)
- FF009 Wall Quilts, Appliqued
- FF010 Wall Quilts, Mixed Techniques
- FF011 Wall Quilts, Mixed Techniques with embellishments
- FF012 Wall Quilts, Pieced
- FF013 Quilts - Hand sewn, non-machine
