RULES AND REGULATIONS

- All entries must be the work of the exhibitor.
- All articles must be made by hand, and completed between September, 2018 and September, 2019.
- If an entry is misrepresented or the exhibitor misrepresents his/her status, the entry will be disqualified.
- There shall not be more than one ribbon awarded and one award paid for each placement in a class.

AWARDS

Blue Ribbon	\$10.00	First place within a particular class.
Red Ribbon	\$6.00	Second place within a particular class.
White Ribbon	\$4.00	Third place within a particular class.
Best of Show	Rosette	This award represents the best entry within this subdepartment that has placed "First" in a given class within this subdepartment.
Judge's Choice	Rosette	This award represents the "judge's choice" within each category.

Exhibitor must choose between Amateur and Professional. One CANNOT enter both.

Amateur-Any person making jewelry items for pleasure only. This person does not derive income from that specific handicraft.

Professional-Any person connected with a jewelry craft business or workshop as owner, instructor, attendant, etc., or anyone making pieces or working for personal monetary gain from their hobby. In this category, special consideration will be given to pieces with completely hand-fabricated components (no purchased findings).
